## NURSING BURSARY CRITERIA

### The HSS Bursary achievement criteria

- **First year students** are eligible for a bursary depending on Grade Point Average (GPA). Bursaries range from \$1250 to \$2000.
- **Second year students** are eligible for a bursary depending on GPA. Bursaries range from \$2000 to \$4000.
- **Third and fourth year students** are eligible for a bursary depending on GPA. Bursaries range from \$4000 to \$6000.

To be eligible for the minimum bursary a cumulative grade average of 60% and higher must be obtained. This bursary is provided once per year in the 'winter semester' and based on the GPA from the completed 'fall semester' of the current academic year. The amount awarded to each student is dependant on their GPA. This means the bursary is awarded during the first few weeks of January.

### Queen Elizabeth II Scholarship

This is given out annually to the **top two students** (one beneficiary and one non-beneficiary) in the second, third and fourth year of the nursing program with the **highest cumulative** GPA to date. This scholarship is provided once a year and administered at the end of September. Each recipient receives \$3,000.
